Big Bay is a small town with a population of around 500 people literally at the end of a county road. As such, lodging, dining, groceries and other services are limited.

Bay Cliff Health Camp

Cost: \$150

Includes: 3 nights of lodging starting either Thursday or Friday night and 3 meals per day from Friday to Sunday.

Location: Bay Cliff is the site of the IDW classroom sessions with rooms and meals located within walking distance.

Food: Family style breakfast, lunch and dinner as scheduled in the class syllabus. Allergies, vegetarians, etc. can usually be accommodated given adequate notice.

Lodging: Most rooms are dorm style with shared bathroom facilities. Separate male and female housing with accommodations available for married couples.

Linen: None provided. Bring your own pillows, towels, sheets, and blankets (or sleeping bag).

Rules: Camp does have rules everyone needs to follow including no swearing, no alcohol and no smoking.
